This action should only be used in an emergency by a person who has an established legal right to physical custody and possession of a minor child through:

- A COURT ORDER that awards legal custody or time-sharing to the petitioner;
 OR
- 2. OPERATION OF LAW Petitioner is the birth mother of the child(ren), born out of wedlock, and no court has addressed any other person's parental rights.
