**NON-JURY TRIAL IN A COMPLEX CASE**


Having conferred and designated this case as complex pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2021-09, the parties shall comply with Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.201,

5. Any party may seek modification of this Order for cause shown.
