



**NOTICE REGARDING VIRTUAL SUPERVISED TIME-SHARING, FAMILY COURT,
IN THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA**

Effective March 23, 2020, on a temporary basis, supervised visitations being held at Jewish Family & Community Services (Safety-First Project) and Family Nurturing Center may be conducted by video conference until further notice.

Virtual Supervised Timesharing: Any and all parties under an Order for supervised timesharing shall continue to comply with the provisions of such Orders. If the facility or organization through which the supervised timesharing is facilitated has the ability to provide virtual (i.e. Zoom, Skype, Facetime, etc.) visits, the parties shall use their best efforts to participate in the virtual visits at the same frequency as they previously participated in in person visits. Parties shall comply with all rules and regulations of the supervised timesharing provider regarding the virtual visits.
